DIRECTORY DESCRIPTION AND AUTHORITY INFORMATION

This directory is a listing of all West Virginia Board of Education (WVBE) required licensure assessments for educator certification and for completion of WVBE approved programs leading to West Virginia licensure. This directory is maintained on the West Virginia Department of Education website and pursuant to rules for WVBE approved testing found in West Virginia State Code (ex. Sections §18A-3-1 through §18A-3-2a) and WVBE Policies (ex. 5202, 5100 and 5901).

LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS **(Pre-Professional, Content, and Pedagogical Knowledge and Skills)**

All Applicants must submit documentation meeting the following requirements:

1. Pre-Professional Skills Assessments; AND
2. Content Assessment(s) - Review the applicable content assessment(s) and passing scores required for each endorsement area, in accordance with appropriate grade levels, in the specialization tables of this document; AND
3. Professional Education Assessments

Test Score Validity

The validity period for in-state and out-of-state assessments and passing scores is ten years from the date on which the candidate passed the examination if such assessments were the assessments required in the WVBE policy or out of-state policy (if applicable) effective at the time the assessments were taken, except when the assessment creator specifies otherwise¹. Candidates whose assessment score(s) exceed the ten-year validity period at the time of application for licensure are required to satisfy current assessments and passing scores. In those circumstances where the WVBE has not altered either the required assessment or the passing score, the assessment and score shall remain valid beyond the ten-year period.

When assessments, scores, or industry credentials listed in the manual are modified, the validity period for the previously listed assessment, score, and/or industry credential shall be one year from the effective date of the new assessment, score, or industry credential, except when the assessment creator specifies otherwise.

12 Month Rule – Applicants have 12 months after successfully completing a WVBE approved program to apply for licensure without having to meet any new program requirements if changes have been made.

Exception—Assessments, scores, or industry credentials shall remain valid for 12 months after completion of an approved program for licensure where the candidate was continuously enrolled even if the assessments, scores, or industry credentials have been modified.

Pre-Professional (Basic) Skills Assessment scores may be used beyond the ten-year limit and may be used to satisfy the pre-professional skills assessment requirement.

¹ Assessment may be accepted beyond the validity specified by the assessment creator (not to exceed four years) if the applicant is continuously enrolled in an eligible program and provides documentation of continuing attempts to pass assessments, which are not more than three months apart, to complete all program requirements.

When adding endorsements to a Professional Teaching Certificate via content proficiency, please see WVBE Policy 5202, for assessment validity. **West Virginia does not permit the use of the Praxis Bridge Option to add an endorsement through the content proficiency option.**

ETS Praxis Bridge Option – This is an alternative passing method for select Praxis assessments. Instead of retaking the full assessment, eligible candidates can complete a learning module provided through ETS to demonstrate their competency and earn a passing score currently shown as “alt pass” on a score report. To qualify, candidates must have attempted a Praxis assessment approved for the Bridge Option in West Virginia and scored within one standard error of measurement (SEM) of the passing score, as defined in the WV Licensure Testing Directory. Individuals may be exempt from the WVBE-required assessments for pre-professional skills (Reading, Writing, Mathematics), provided they meet one of the following criteria:

- Holds a conferred Bachelor’s Degree from an accredited Institution of Higher Education with an overall cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0; or
 - Holds a current National Board Certified Teacher credential; or
 - Holds or has held a West Virginia Professional Certificate; or
 - Holds a master’s degree from an accredited institution of higher education; or
 - Individuals enrolled in a state approved EPP resulting in an MA; or
 - Has attained a composite score of 25 on the American College Test (ACT) (prior to November 1989); or
 - Has attained a composite score of 21 on the ACT (on or after November 1, 1989); or
 - Has a 1035 on the Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT) (prior to April 1995); or
 - Has a 1125 on the re-centered SAT (effective April 1995); or
 - Has a 1170 on the revised SAT using the combined Critical Reading and Math score (effective March 2005); or
 - Has attained a New SAT score of 480 using the combined Evidence- Based Reading and Writing and a score of [Type here]
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- 530 in Math. Candidates may use scores from multiple administrations (effective May 2016); or
- Has attained from a single administration a combined score of 800 verbal and quantitative (tested prior to November 2011) on the Graduate Record Examination (GRE); or
- Has attained from a single administration at least a 286 (November 2011 or after) on the GRE; or
- Satisfies a passing score in basic skills reading, writing and mathematics as required in the state where the preparation program is or was completed; or
- Holds a valid out-of-state certificate in the content area in which West Virginia certification is available and requested; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent; or
- Holds documentation of successfully completing three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state professional certificate, valid during those three years; or
- Holds a license issued by the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses; or
- Holds a passing score on the current Elementary Education Multiple Subject PRAXIS Assessments or Elementary Education Content Knowledge for Teaching (CKT) PRAXIS Assessments required for West Virginia licensure; or
- Obtained a score that is two standard error of measurement (SEM) above the adopted content assessment cut score for which licensure is sought; or
- Has attained a 'B' or better in each of three courses addressing the basic skills of reading, writing, and mathematics at an accredited Institution of Higher Education providing that each course is a minimum of three semester credit hours (or equivalent).
 - Reading -To demonstrate the ability to comprehend, analyze, and interpret various types of text
 - Writing - To ensure ideas can be expressed in written form, with a focus on clarity, organization, and grammar
 - Mathematics - To demonstrate competency in fundamental math concepts

For exemption from the Reading and Writing Pre-Professional Skills Assessments only:

- Has attained a minimum combined score of 34 on the ACT assessment (effective on or after November 1, 1989) in both English and Reading with a minimum individual score of 17 for each individual subject (English and Reading). Eligible scores for English and Reading on the ACT enhanced assessment may be combined from multiple administrations of the assessment; or
- Has attained a New SAT score of 480 using the combined Evidence- Based Reading and Writing. Candidates may use scores from multiple administrations (effective May 2016).

For exemption from the Mathematics Pre-Professional Skills Assessment only:

- Has attained a minimum individual score of 19 on the ACT assessment (through June 30, 2023) in mathematics during any administration of the assessment; or
- Has attained a minimum individual score of 21 on the ACT assessment (after July 1, 2023) in mathematics during any administration of the assessment; or
- Has attained an SAT score of 530 in Math. Candidates may use scores from multiple administrations (effective May 2016).

Notes on exemptions from pre-professional skills assessments using ACT (effective on or after November 1989) scores: Applicants may use the average of the best ACT scores from each subject on multiple attempts of the assessment to meet a combined score or composite score exemption, with the exception of the writing section score, which is not figured into a composite score.

PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION ASSESSMENT(S) REQUIREMENTS²

Applicants must attain a passing score on the appropriate assessment, according to the programmatic level of the endorsement being sought, as described in the charts below. **The Professional Education Assessment(s) is not required for an educator seeking West Virginia licensure in a student support or administrative specialization. West Virginia does not permit the use of the Praxis Bridge to meet the Professional Education Assessment requirements.**

ALLOWABLE ASSESSMENT EXEMPTIONS

(As per WVBE Policy 5202)

The following exemptions are established by the WVBE for required assessments of professional licensure:

Content Specialization Assessment(s)

The requirement for passing WVBE-required assessment(s) for content specializations may be exempted, provided the individual meets one of the following criteria:

- Holds a current National Board Certified Teacher credential; or
- Holds a valid and equivalent out-of-state license in the area in which West Virginia certification is available and requested; or
- Holds a Doctorate Degree in the content area for which West Virginia licensure is available and requested; or
- Holds a Master's degree in the content area for which West Virginia licensure is available and requested, and five years of directly related work experience in the area; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent in the desired content area; or
- Has successfully completed three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state professional certificate valid during those three years.

Professional Education Assessment(s)

The requirement for passing WVBE-required assessment(s) for professional education may be exempted, provided the individual meets one of the following criteria:

- Holds a current National Board Certified Teacher credential; or
- Satisfied a passing score on the appropriate professional education assessment as required in the state where the preparation program is or was completed (Teaching Reading, Praxis 5205 is not included under this exemption⁵); or
- Satisfied a passing score on the appropriate professional education assessment which is included as part of a WVBE approved program; or
- Holds a valid out-of-state Professional Certificate; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent; or
- Has successfully completed three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state professional certificate valid during those three years; or

GPA REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL LICENSURE

- Minimum GPA 2.5 with a Bachelor's Degree; or
- A GPA of 2.0 or greater with a Bachelor's Degree and has obtained a score that is two standard error of measurements (SEM+2) above for any and all of the adopted content assessment(s) cut score; or
- A GPA of 2.0 or greater with a Bachelor's Degree and three years of substitute or full-time teaching experience with a minimum of 133 days in a school year at an accredited K-12 public school system or a non-public school that has been accredited through a WVBE-approved accreditation agency as prescribed in W. Va. 126CSR13C, Policy 2330. A school or county administrator's recommendation is required to verify each year of substitute or full-time teaching experience.
- Holds a Doctorate Degree in the content area for which West Virginia licensure is available and requested; or
- Holds a Master's degree in the content area for which West Virginia licensure is available and requested, and five years of directly related work experience in the area; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent in the desired content area; or

- Has successfully completed three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state professional certificate valid during those three years.

Professional Education Assessment(s)

The requirement for passing WVBE-required assessment(s) for professional education may be exempted, provided the individual meets one of the following criteria:

- Holds a current National Board Certified Teacher credential; or
- Satisfied a passing score on the appropriate professional education assessment as required in the state where the preparation program is or was completed (Teaching Reading, Praxis 5205 is not included under this exemption⁶); or
- Satisfied a passing score on the appropriate professional education assessment which is included as part of a WVBE approved program; or
- Holds a valid out-of-state Professional Certificate; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent; or
- Has successfully completed three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state professional certificate valid during those three years; or

GPA REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL LICENSURE

- Minimum GPA 2.5 with a Bachelor's Degree; or
- A GPA of 2.0 or greater with a Bachelor's Degree and has obtained a score that is two standard error of measurements (SEM+2) above for any and all of the adopted content assessment(s) cut score; or
- A GPA of 2.0 or greater with a Bachelor's Degree and three years of substitute or full-time teaching experience with a minimum of 133 days in a school year at an accredited K-12 public school system or a non-public school that has been accredited through a WVBE-approved accreditation agency as prescribed in W. Va. 126CSR13C, Policy 2330. A school or county administrator's recommendation is required to verify each year of substitute or full-time teaching experience.
