
Establishing Conventional Gestures



- **General Strategy (Partner):** replace unconventional behaviors with conventional ones in existing routines and provide opportunities to use Level IV behaviors in social contexts. Individual already uses intentional communication in regular routines. New opportunities are provided in those same routines.
- Targeted Behaviors (Response): wave, nod/shake the head, alternate gaze, point, give, show, shrug shoulders, hug, kiss, pat.
- Partner's Response: respond appropriately according to individual's intent.

Outcome: individual learns to communicate in a more socially acceptable manner. New Level IV intents are demonstrated (greet, offer, direct attention, polite social forms, answer/ask questions).
