West Virginia Department of Education (WVDE), West Virginia Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and West Virginia School Building Authority (SBA)

Agencies will collaborate to provide all available resources to improve facilities and enhance understanding of how to prevent and respond to a school safety incident

School Safety Coordinator

- Acts as liaison between the WVDE and DHS
 Blends safety and security need with educational best practice
- ► Assists in WVDE and DHS initiatives
- Supervises 6 regional school-safety directors
- ▶ Works with county and school administrators to develop a safety needs assessment
- ► Stays current with research-based methods of prevention and response and informs school safety directors and county/school personnel
- ► Coordinates school-based efforts with DHS, WVDE, FBI, and each county and implements efficient communication among all stakeholders
- Communicates with WV Prevention Resource and School Resource Officers regarding school safety needs

School Safety Directors

- Regionally based
- When requested by counties:
 - Provide technical assistance related to school-safety initiatives, needs assessments, and crisis response plans
 - Conduct school safety audits and provide recommendations
 - Provide training on research-based methods of prevention and response
- ► Facilitate communication among counties, schools, and law enforcement agencies
