STATEWIDE CONTRACTS

- Contract between the state and vendor which is used by state agencies and some political subdivisions to purchase frequently used commodities and services
- Bid and managed by the Purchasing Division

STATEWIDE CONTRACTS

- Benefits of using statewide contracts
 - Quick (Available to use right now)
 - Cost savings (The volume savings over the life of the contract)
 - Easily accessible
 - Efficiency in the procurement process
 - Reduces Soft Costs?
 - Mitigate risks!
 - All vendors on SWC's are properly vetted with SOS, Tax, Workers Comp, Fed % State Debarments.
 - Time is money!
