

ORDER FOR EXCESS LEVY ELECTION
FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE COUNTY OF JACKSON
TO THE VOTERS OF THE COUNTY OF JACKSON
TAKE NOTICE

That at a regular meeting of the Board of Education of the County of Jackson, State of West Virginia, held on the 2nd day of September, 2021, as provided by law, the following order was made and entered on record, to wit:

The Board of Education of the County of Jackson, being of the opinion that the maximum levies for current expenses authorized by Article 8, Chapter 11 of the Code of West Virginia, as last amended, will not provide sufficient funds for the payment of current expenses of the Board of Education of the County of Jackson, including expenditures for the purposes hereinafter set forth, and that an election should be held to increase such levies under the provisions of Section 16, Article 8, Chapter 11 of the Code, as last amended, it is hereby ordered:

1. That the purpose for which additional funds are needed and the annual approximate amount for such purposes after due allowances for exonerations, delinquencies, etc., are as follows:
 - a. To provide funds to repair, improve, and maintain the existing Board owned motor vehicles and where necessary to purchase new and additional motor vehicles in order to facilitate a safe and efficient school system at a rate of five percent (5%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of . . \$546,554
 - b. To provide funds to distribute free textbooks and workbooks to all students in the Jackson County School District, and to supply and equip elementary and secondary schools at the rate of ten percent (10%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of\$1,093,109
 - c. To provide funds to repair, improve, add to, and maintain all school facilities, to defray utility costs, and to provide funds for land and for the construction of buildings thereon or upon any land now owned by the Board of Education at the rate of twenty-five percent (25%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of \$2,732,772
 - d. To provide funds for the employment of additional school system personnel to meet the needs of the school system and to maintain and/or increase the present supplement to the state basic salary scale and provide benefits for all school personnel at the rate of sixty percent (60%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of \$6,558,654

2. That the total approximate amounts needed during the term of this five (5) year levy after due allowances for exonerations, delinquencies, etc., for said purposes is approximately \$54,655,445.
3. That the separate and aggregate assessed valuation of each class of taxable property within the Jackson County School District is as follows:

Class I	\$ 0
Class II	580,775,482
Class III	833,107,263
Class IV	169,113,183
Aggregate	\$1,582,995,928

4. That the proposed additional rate of levy in cents on each class of property is as follows:

Class I - 22.95 cents per each \$100.00 valuation
Class II - 45.90 cents per each \$100.00 valuation
Class III - 91.80 cents per each \$100.00 valuation
Class IV - 91.80 cents per each \$100.00 valuation

5. That the proposed years to which the additional levy shall apply are the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2024; July 1, 2025; July 1, 2026; July 1, 2027; July 1, 2028.
6. That the Board of Education will not issue bonds upon the approval of the proposed levy.
7. That the questions of such additional levy shall be submitted to a vote at the Primary Election to be held on the 10th day of May, 2022.

BOARD OF EDUCATION OF

Special election to authorize additional levies for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2024; July 1, 2025; July 1, 2026; July 1, 2027; and July 1, 2028; for the purposes set forth as follows:

1. That the purposes for which additional funds are needed and the annual approximate amount for such purposes after due allowances for exonerations, delinquencies, etc., are as follows:

A. To provide funds to repair, improve, and maintain the existing Board owned motor vehicles and where necessary to purchase new and additional motor vehicles in order to facilitate a safe and efficient school system at the rate of five percent (5%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of \$546,554

B. To provide funds to distribute free textbooks and workbooks to all students in the Jackson County School District, and to supply and equip elementary and secondary schools at the rate of ten percent (10%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of \$1,093,109

C. To provide funds to repair, improve, add to, and maintain all school facilities, to defray utility costs, and to provide funds for land and for the construction of buildings thereon or upon any land now owned by the Board of Education at the rate of twenty-five percent (25%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of \$2,732,772

D. To provide funds for the employment of additional school system personnel to meet the needs of the school system and to maintain and/or increase the present supplement to the state basic salary scale and provide benefits for all school personnel at the rate of sixty percent (60%) of the total annual additional levy proceeds, for an approximate annual cost of \$6,558,654

2. That the total approximate amounts needed during the term of this five-year (5) levy after due allowances for exonerations, delinquencies, etc., for said purposes is approximately \$54,655,445

All according to the order of the Board of Education of the County of Jackson entered on the 2nd day of September, 2021.

The additional levy shall be on Class I property 22.95 cents; on Class II property 45.90 cents; on Class III property 91.80 cents; and on Class IV property 91.80 cents. Such additional levies shall be based on each one hundred dollars valuation of Classes I, II, III, and IV property.
