



## Digital Art/Media Portfolio

Auditioning for digital art/media requires the creation of a portfolio.

### Portfolio Requirements:

Students should submit three to five (3-5) pieces of digital artwork or digital photographs of fine art, included from at least two different areas below:

- Photography
- Digital Vector Illustration (using software such as Adobe Illustrator and Inkscape)
- Digital Raster Illustration (using software such as Procreate and ibis Paint X)
- Graphic Design (such as logo design or posters)
- Page Layout (such as flyers, programs or brochures)
- Digital Collage (using multiple images within one digital artwork)
- Digitally photographed fine art (such as drawing, painting or printmaking)
- Video (Any type of video created where multiple clips, audio, music, or graphics have been combined)
- Animation

All photos, digital illustrations, graphic design elements, page layouts, or digital compositions should be submitted as PDF or JPEG files.

### File Submission

- Create a PDF file with all the links to your digital artwork or videos. Include your First and Last Name, School, and "Digital Art/Media Portfolio" as a title of the file. **Please ensure you have granted public access to all files.**
- Upload the PDF to the file submission location below.
- **You must include your first and last name in the file name.**
