- A resident of West Virginia
- A freshman or sophomore at the time of application
- Have a grade-point average of at least 3.0
- Have a recommendation from the school principal (within this application)
- Must satisfy all immunization requirements set by the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR). Nonpublic school and homeschool students must provide proof of immunizations.

#### General Information:

- The state deadline for Part I and II of the application is Friday, April 3, 2026 at 11:50 PM. It is the responsibility of the student to collect all required documents and submit Part II to the upload folder.
- Part II of the application (this form and all supporting documents as required within the application) are submitted directly to the state file submission location (on last page of this application).
- A copy of transcripts is required with the application. This document will need to be provided by the school counselor.
- Within the application, you will be required to secure two recommendations. Please provide sufficient notice to your teacher prior to submitting the application.
- On the final page of this application, you will find a checklist of all required pieces. It is your responsibility as the student to scan all components into a PDF and submit the entire application file to the upload folder. We recommend asking a teacher or counselor to review all your information before you submit it.
- Students may not apply to attend GCSI if they have attended in the past.
- IMPORTANT: WV Governor's Schools is a summer commitment for students. If you are selected to attend and you confirm your participation, we expect you to fully participate in the programs. If you decide to leave voluntarily during the school, you will not be permitted to apply for any other Governor's Schools in the future.
