At a regular session of the Tyler County Commission held at the Courthouse thereof on the 23rd day of October, 2012 at 9:00 A.M.

Present: President Charles A. Smith, and John F. Stender.

Mr. Jeff Davis, Tyler County Board of Education, presented the Commission with the Resolution for the Levy Election on December 15, 2012. He stated the Levy is a continuation of the levy that has been in effect since 1949.

Mr. Smith read the Resolution and on motion of Mr. Stender, the Commission unanimously approved the signing of the following Resolution:

BY THE TYLER COUNTY COMMISSION

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Tyler County Commission recognizes that a strong K-12 education system is a key element in economic growth; and

WHEREAS, schools are an integral part of the communities in Tyler County; and

WHEREAS, the Tyler County Schools' Excess Levy comprises approximately 16% or 2.48 million dollars of the total school budget; and

WHEREAS, local support, through the Excess Levy, provides students free textbooks, library books, field trips, computers, software, and other technology tools in the classroom, and a safe, clean learning environment; and

WHEREAS, school systems are required by both the Constitution and State Board of Education policy to provide a thorough and efficient education program that, due to under funding through the State School-Aid Formula, make attainment of these standards of accountability unattainable without local funds;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Tyler County Commission supports the continuation of the Tyler County Schools' Excess Levy, which represents a 5-year operating levy with NO tax increase.

**TO THE VOTERS OF TYLER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
TAKE NOTICE**

That, at a regular meeting of the Board of Education of the County of Tyler, State of West Virginia, held on the 4th of September, 2012 the following order was duly made, seconded and entered of record.

The Board of Education of the County of Tyler, a West Virginia Corporation, being of the opinion that the maximum levies for current expenses authorized by Chapter 11, Article 8 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, will not provide sufficient funds for the payment of current expenses of the Board of Education of the County of Tyler, including purposes herein- after set forth, and that an election should be held to renew additional levies which were last renewed by the voters of Tyler County School District, December 14, 2007, under the provisions of Chapter 11, Article 8, Section 16 of the Code of West Virginia, as amended, it is therefore ordered:

I. The purposes for which funds are needed, in order to maintain and improve the instructional programs and school services in the Tyler County School District are as follows:

A. To continue the furnishing of free textbooks for all students in grades Pre-K through 12, inclusive, and to provide workbooks and other necessary supplemental materials such as computer software which will assist in use of the textbooks in the annual approximate amount of \$286,000.

B. To further upgrade our educational curriculum by providing Library/Media supplies, books, equipment and services in the approximate annual amount of \$120,000.

C. To repair, maintain, upgrade, and replace computer equipment and software to continue to improve the use of technology in instruction in the approximate annual amount of \$249,000.

D. To continue maintenance of buildings and equipment necessary for safe and efficient operation in the approximate annual amount of \$316,000.

E. To provide a safe, efficient, and adequate transportation system for the school children of Tyler County through the purchase of transportation equipment, parts and services in the approximate annual amount of \$41,000.

F. To continue to provide a Dental/Optical Benefit plan for all personnel in the approximate annual amount of \$160,000.

G. To upgrade and improve the instructional program of the Tyler County School District by the employment of, and keeping of, qualified teachers, service and administrative personnel through maintenance of a competitive salary position and benefits in the approximate annual amount of \$1,133,000.

H. To provide curricular and extra-curricular salary support for academic and athletic coaches in the approximate annual amount of \$122,000.

I. To provide, maintain, upgrade, and replace duplication equipment and provide materials for equipment operation in the approximate annual amount of \$61,000.

II. That the approximate amount for said purposes, after making due allowance for delinquencies and exonerations is approximately \$2,488,000 annually and the total approximate amount to be expended during the term of this levy is \$12,440,000.

III. That the separate and aggregate assessed valuation of each class of taxable property within the Tyler County School District is for the year 2012 as follows:

IV. That the proposed renewal of 100% rate of levy in cents on each class of property is as follows:

Class I	22.95
Class II	45.90
Class III	91.80
Class IV	91.80

Provided, however, that the Tyler County Board of Education reserves unto itself as the levying body the right and the authority to reduce the rates of the excess levy if increased assessments would produce funds beyond projected needs in any year specified in the levy call in accordance with the provisions in West Virginia Code 11-8-6g.

The Tyler County Board of Education is hereby authorized to expend any excess funds raised by the levy rate herein set forth for public school purposes to the extent permitted by law.

IV. That the proposed years to which the additional levy shall apply are the fiscal years beginning July 1,2013; July 1,2014;July 1,2015;July 1,2016; and July 1,2017.

V. That the Board of Education of the County of Tyler in issuing the renewal of excess levies, shall not include issuing of bonds.

VI. That the question of such renewal of additional levy shall be submitted to a vote at a special election, to be held on the 15th day of December 2012.

VII. That the notice calling such election shall be given by publication of this Order at least once a week for two successive weeks before said election, in the Tyler Star News, that being the only newspaper of general circulation in the Tyler County School District.

VIII. That the number of election officials necessary to properly conduct said election is three commissioners and two clerks at each place of voting. Canvassing of the returns from said special levy election shall be by the Board of Education of the County of Tyler as provided by law. All other provisions of the laws concerning general elections shall apply as far as they are practicable.

IX. That in the event additional money shall be obtained by grant or otherwise from the State or Federal Government, or any state or government agencies, for use in school buildings in the County School District, or for matching funds for current school purposes, such additional money may be used either in substitution for or in addition to the proceeds derived from the said levies as may be fixed by the Board and the granting agency. If additional buildings are constructed from funds so obtained, the proceeds from said levies may be used in connection with any such state or federal grant for use in such additional work.
