

# Community Programs Authorization for Lead Teacher





#### **Initial Community Programs Authorization**

- Requirements as of August 1, 2013:
- (a) Degree. The minimum of a bachelor's degree in child development, early childhood, or occupational development with an emphasis in child development/early childhood; **AND**
- (b) Experience. Verification of at least one year of early education teaching experience; **AND**





#### **Initial Community Programs Authorization**

- c) Commitment Submission of commitment verifying the applicant's agreement to complete coursework and/or professional development in the areas specified by the WVDE Office of Early Learning; **AND**
- (d) Recommendation of the county superintendent OR the community program's director





#### **Initial Community Programs Authorization**

If the bachelor's degree is in an area other than child development, early childhood, or occupational development with an emphasis in child development/early childhood, then a waiver request for the degree area *must* be submitted by the county superintendent or the agency director for the Form 50 initial application.





Community Programs Authorization Renewal

Six (6) semester hours of WVDEapproved coursework or equivalent professional development are required for each renewal, as defined and approved by the WVDE Office of Early Learning, until all requirements have been met for a permanent authorization.





#### **Permanent Community Programs Authorization**

Completion of all requirements as stated in WV Board of Education Policy 5202, §126-136-11.9.c.1.EE.
