This Manual is maintained on the WVDE website. When tests, scores, or industry credentials listed in the manual are changed, the validity period for the previously listed test, score, and/or industry credential shall be one year from the effective date of the new test, score, or industry credential. Exception: tests, scores, or industry credentials shall remain valid for twelve months after completion of an approved program for licensure where the applicant was continuously enrolled even if the test, score, or industry credential has changed.
