



WV Learns One-Credit Hour Modules Summer 2022 Professional Learning Catalog Schedule and Additional Details

DATES:

June 1, 2022 – September 1, 2022 (rolling enrollment through July 10, 2022)

PROCESS:

- ▶ Three self-paced courses that each provide one-credit hour toward non-degree graduate credit.
- ▶ Participants may apply the course certificate of completion, awarded after successful course completion, toward certificate renewal. If individuals desire to apply course credit toward advanced salary reclassification, then the Concord University registration form and payment information will be sent to participants upon course completion via a course generated email.

SELF-PACED MODULES:

▶ **Module 1: All About Addiction** (1 credit hour)

This self-paced module is designed to be completed over a period of 2-3 weeks with a focus on defining and recognizing scams, identifying characteristics of plagiarism, the correct use of copyright material, and dangers inherent in social media.

Note: All module participants must be new to the topic and not have previously completed the All About Addiction: Understanding Opioids and Other Addicting Substances 3-hour course.

▶ **Module 2: Cyber Safety** (1 credit hour)

This self-paced module is designed to be completed over a period of 2-3 weeks with a focus on defining and recognizing scams, identifying characteristics of plagiarism, the correct use of copyright material, and dangers inherent in social media.

Note: All module participants must be new to the topic and not have previously completed the Cyber Safety 3-hour course.

▶ **Module 3: Universal Design for Learning** (1 credit hour)

This self-paced course is designed to be completed over a 2 to 3 week period with a focus on understanding the basics of UDL, reflecting on ways UDL can be implemented into classroom activities, and identifying ways to make instruction accessible and engaging.

Note: All module participants must be new to the topic and not have previously completed the Universal Design for Learning 3-hour course.

MODULE DELIVERY:

MODULE REQUIREMENTS:

The courses will require the completion of projects specific to module.

MODULE CREDIT:

Fall 2022 course credit to be awarded by Concord University after December 15, 2022, for \$33.00 per one credit hour. Upon module completion non-degree graduate credit registration forms will be sent to course participants via a course-generated email.

CERTIFICATION OF COMPLETION:

Upon module completion a course-generated email will be sent to participants with instructions for locating the certificate of completion.
