COURSE DESIGN:

WVDE provides twelve self-paced paraprofessional courses. All courses are designed such that each of the six or seven content sessions includes readings and resources, study guides and guizzes.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

The paraprofessional courses are self-paced auto-graded courses. When completing each content section, paraprofessionals must read the session content and then complete the quiz for that session. Study guides should be completed. Participants must earn a minimum score of 90% for the quiz in each course content session. Quizzes may be completed multiple times.
