DIRECTORY DESCRIPTION AND AUTHORITY INFORMATION

This directory is a listing of all West Virginia Board of Education (WVBE) required licensure exams for educator certification and for completion of WVBE approved programs leading to West Virginia licensure. This directory is maintained on the West Virginia Department of Education website and pursuant to rules for WVBE approved testing found in West Virginia State Code (ex. Sections §18A-3-1 through §18A-3-2a) and WVBE Policies (ex. 5202, 5100 and 5901).

LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS

(Pre-Professional, Content, and Pedagogical Knowledge and Skills)

All Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Documentation of Pre-Professional Skills using one of the allowable requirements included within this directory.
- 2. Praxis II Content Test Review the applicable content test(s) and passing scores required for each endorsement area, in accordance with appropriate grade levels, in the specialization tables of this document; AND
- 3. Professional Education Exams (see requirement details on the next page).
- *** Beginning immediately, July 1, 2023, the Core Academic Skills for Educators (CASE) exam will no longer be required for program admission for candidates completing a traditional teacher preparation program.
- ***WVDE Alternative Certification Programs must meet the Pre-Professional Skills Test/Basic Skills Test requirements or qualify for an eligible exemption.
- ***Candidates who are admitted into a teacher preparation program after January 1, 2024, are not required to complete the Basic Skills Exam for certification purposes but must meet one of the exemptions listed starting on page 4 of this directory.

If more than one endorsement is sought on an initial Professional Teaching Certificate (including the Provisional Professional Teaching Certificate), the individual must pass a minimum of one appropriate Principles of Learning and Teaching exams or TPA if applicable, in accordance with programmatic level of the endorsementbeing sought, as described in the tables above.

Test Score Validity:

The validity period for in-state and out-of-state tests and passing scores is ten years from the date on which the candidate passed the examination if such tests were the tests required in the WVBE policy (or out of-state policy if applicable) effective at the time the tests were taken, except when the test creator specifies otherwise. In those circumstances where the WVBE has not altered either the required test or the passing score, the test and score shall remain valid beyond the ten-year period. Candidates whose test score(s) exceed the ten-year validity period at the time of application for licensure are required to satisfy current tests and passing scores.

Basic Skills Test scores may be used beyond the ten-year limit and may be used to satisfy the pre-professional skills test requirement.

Failure to Apply for Licensure:

A candidate who fails to apply for licensure within 12 months from the completion of an approved program for licensure is required to satisfy any program components in effect at the time of application and to comply with conditions outlined for the validity period.

Pre-Professional Skills Requirements

Individuals may be exempt from the WVBE-required tests for pre-professional skills (Reading, Writing, Mathematics), provided they meet one of the following criteria:

• Core Academic Skills for Educators (CASE) – Applicants must pass three of the following exams, specifically one reading, one writing, and one mathematics exam;

- Holds a conferred Bachelor's Degree from an accredited Institution of Higher Education with an overall cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0; or
- Holds certification through the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS); or
- Holds or has held a West Virginia Professional Certificate; or
- Holds a master's degree from an accredited institution of higher education; or
- Individuals enrolled in a state approved EPP resulting in an MA; or
- Has attained a composite score of 25 on the American College Test (ACT) (prior to November 1989); or
- Has attained a composite score of 21 on the ACT (on or after November 1, 1989); or
- Has a 1035 on the Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT) (prior to 1995); or
- Has a 1125 on the re-centered SAT (effective April 1995); or
- Has a 1170 on the revised SAT using the combined Critical Reading and Math score (effective March 2005); or
- Has attained a New SAT score of 480 using the combined Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and a score of 530 in Math. Candidates may use scores from multiple administrations (effective May 2016); or
- Has attained from a single administration a combined score of 800 verbal and quantitative (tested prior to November 2011) on the Graduate Record Examination (GRE); or
- Has attained from a single administration at least a 286 (November 2011 or after) on the GRE;
 or
- Satisfies a passing score in basic skills reading, writing and mathematics as required in the state where the preparation program is or was completed; or
- Holds a valid out-of-state certificate in the content area in which West Virginia certification is available and requested; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent; or
- Holds documentation of successfully completing three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state

- professional certificate, valid during those three years; or
- Holds a license issued by the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses; or
- Holds a passing score on the current Elementary Education Multiple Subject PRAXIS Exams required for West Virginia licensure; or
- Obtained a score that is two standard error of measurement (SEM) above the adopted content exam cut score for which licensure is sought; or
- Has attained a 'B' or better in each of three courses addressing the basic skills of reading, writing, and mathematics (as indicated by college and career ready standards) at an accredited Institution of Higher Education providing that each course is a minimum of three semester credit hours (or equivalent).

For exemption from the Reading and Writing Pre-Professional Skills Test only:

- Has attained a minimum combined score of 34 on the ACT exam (effective on or after November 1, 1989) in both English and Reading with a minimum individual score of 17 for each individual subject (English and Reading). Eligible scores for English and Reading on the ACT enhanced exam may be combined from multiple administrations of the exam; or
- Has attained a New SAT score of 480 using the combined Evidence-Based Reading and Writing. Candidates may use scores from multiple administrations (effective May 2016).

For exemption from the Mathematics Pre-Professional Skills Test only:

- Has attained a minimum individual score of 19 on the ACT exam (through June 30, 2023) in mathematics during any administration of the test; or
- Has attained a minimum individual score of 21 on the ACT exam (after July 1, 2023) in Mathematics during any administration of the test; or
- Has attained an SAT score of 530 In Math. Candidates may use scores from multiple administrations (effective May 2016).

Notes on exemptions from pre-professional skills tests using ACT (effective on or after November 1989) **scores:** Applicants may use the average of the best ACT scores from each subject on multiple attempts of the exam to meet a combined score or composite score exemption, with the exception of the writing section score, which is not figured into a composite score.

ALLOWABLE EXAM EXEMPTIONS

(As per WVBE Policy 5202)

The following exemptions are established by the WVBE for required exams of professional licensure:

Content Specialization Test(s)

The requirement for passing WVBE-required test(s) for content specializations may be exempted, provided the individual meets one of the following criteria:

- Holds certification through the NBPTS; or
- Holds a valid and equivalent out-of-state license in the area in which West Virginia certification is available and requested; or
- Holds a Doctorate Degree in the content area for which West Virginia licensure is available and requested; or
- Holds a Master's degree in the content area for which West Virginia licensure is available and requested, and five years of directly related work experience in the area; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent or equivalent in the desired content area; or
- Has successfully completed three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state professional certificate valid during those three years.

Professional Education Test(s)

The requirement for passing WVBE-required test(s) for professional education may be exempted, provided the individual meets one of the following criteria:

- Holds certification through the NBPTS; or
- Satisfied a passing score on the appropriate professional education test as required in the state where the preparation program is or was completed (Teaching Reading, Praxis 5205 is not included under this exemption); or
- Satisfied a passing score on the appropriate professional education test which is included as part of a WVBE approved program; or
- Holds a valid out-of-state Professional Certificate; or
- Holds an expired out-of-state certificate or equivalent; or
- Has successfully completed three years of experience within the last seven years in one or a combination of specializations recognized on an out-of-state professional certificate valid during those three years; or
- Provide evidence of successfully completing a valid, reliable, and/or nationally normed performance assessment (including but not limited to the edTPA, PPAT, WVTPA) that demonstrates and measures the proficiencies in the professional roles and in the programmatic levels for which the individual is being as adopted by the preparing institution/provider/state. Required passing scores are listed above under the *Professional Exam Requirement section*. This assessment must be aligned with relevant national and West Virginia content and professional standards or as required per the WVBE.

GPA REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL LICENSURE

- Minimum GPA 2.5 (Bachelor's Degree); or
- A GPA of 2.0 or greater (Bachelor's Degree) and has obtained a score that is two standard error of measurements (SEM+2) above for any and all of the adopted content exam(s) cut score; or
- A GPA of 2.0 or greater (Bachelor's Degree) and three years of substitute or full-time teaching experience with a minimum of 133 days in a school year at an accredited K-12 public school system or a non-public school that has been accredited through a WVBE-approved accreditation agency as prescribed in W. Va. 126CSR13C, Policy 2330. A school or county administrator's recommendation is required to verify each year of substitute or full-time teaching experience.
