- 3. A seventh grade student at the time of application
- 4. Must not have attended GSI in the past
- 5. Have a grade-point average of at least 3.0
- 6. Have a recommendation from the school principal (within this application part II)
- 7. Have a recommendation from a math or science teacher (within the application part II)
- 8. Have one other teacher recommendation (within the application part II)

9. Must satisfy all immunization requirements set by the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR). Nonpublic school and homeschool students must provide proof of immunizations.

Once you have completed this part of the application, you may begin Part II by accessing the file at the GSI website.

The state deadline for Part I and II of the application is **April 12, 2024**. Part II is located on the GSI website.






