Common Ground Partnership: Purple Star Award



The Purple Star Award recognizes counties and schools committed to supporting military children and their families for a period of three years. Military-connected children transition between schools on average six to nine times during their K-12 educational experiences. Purple Star Schools and Purple Star Districts are uniquely focused on meeting the needs of students experiencing deployments by creating an inviting and caring culture. This allows soldiers to focus on complex missions conducted in the best interest and defense of our nation.

Purple Star School Requirements Summary:

- » Identify the school's military family point of contact, who successfully completes training on supporting military children and their families.
- » Provide a link to the Common Ground Partnership's homepage, which features a wide variety of useful resources for military families, on the school's website.
- » Describe a local plan for the school to support military children and their families.
- » Commit to annually celebrating Purple Up Day, on a day of the school's choice, during the month of April (the Month of the Military Child).
- » Conduct two qualifying military support activities.

Purple Star District Requirements Summary:

- » Identify a military family point of contact at the county level who successfully completes training on supporting military children and their families.
- » Provide a link to the Common Ground Partnership's homepage on the school district's website.



- » County school board passes a resolution or takes documented action publicizing information about the school system's support for military students and families.
- » All schools within the county have received a Purple Star Award within the past three school years.
