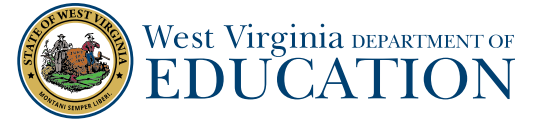


IDEA Indicator 14: Post-School Outcomes

Timelines for Completion



IDEA Indicator 14: Post-School Outcomes is a results indicator which is used to measure effective transition, and is defined as:

Percent of youth with IEPs who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were:

- A. Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school;
- B. Enrolled in higher education or competitively employed;
- C. Enrolled in higher education, other postsecondary education, or training program, or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school

Who is eligible to complete the One Year Follow-Up survey collected in 2024?

Students who exit special education:

- » With an appropriate status code –
 - Code 40** – Graduated: Regular Diploma,
 - Code 55** – Graduated: Alternate Diploma,
 - Code 70** – Reached Maximum Age of 21, or
 - Code 90** – Dropped Out, and
- » Exited during the timeline highlighted below in **GREEN**

NOTE:

Students who have a primary exceptionality of Exceptional Gifted are not eligible to complete the survey. Exceptional Gifted is not a federal disability category.

Students who exit special education during the timeline highlighted in **RED** are not eligible to complete the survey, regardless of the reason for exit (*status code*). Students who exited during the timeline highlighted in **RED** should complete the survey for the following year (*i.e., the survey collected 2025*).
