## **Definitions:**

**Academic Achievement**: Measure of performance on the annual statewide assessments for ELA and mathematics for all students and for each subgroup of students.

**Academic Progress:** Measure of academic improvement over the course of an academic year, using the previous school year's WVGSA results as a baseline measure and the current school year's WVGSA results as the follow-up measure.

**Attendance Indicator:** Measure of student absences from the instructional environment during the academic year

**Behavior Indicator:** The measure of students with no reported discipline referrals that resulted in out-of-school suspension during the academic year.

**Graduation Rate:** The certified high school graduation rates for both the 4-year and 5-year adjusted cohorts.
