Child Nutrition Budget Model

- Meal Counts
 - Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Schools:
 - Meals will only be in the Free and Paid Categories, no reduced meal counts.
 - Meals are allocated between free and paid based on your CEP %.
 - County-wide CEP means you do not charge any students for meals but does not mean you get 100% of your meals reimbursed at the free rate.
 - You will only have zero paid lunches if your CEP % is 100%.
