If the re-evaluation committee answered yes to either question the behavior must be considered to be a manifestation of the student's disability. In that event, the student cannot be expelled, suspended or placed in an alternative education setting for more than ten (10) cumulative school days\*†.

If the committee answered no to both questions the student can be suspended or expelled similar to their non-disabled peers.

\*Note: This does not preclude the parents and the LEA, agreeing on a change of placement. The parents' agreement must be informed, voluntary and not coerced.

**†Note:** Section 504 allows schools to take disciplinary action against students with disabilities using drugs or alcohol to the same extent as students without disabilities.
