


Introduction

Based on a synthesis of available research and expert and stakeholder opinion, the U.S. Department of Education put forth a measurement model that posits that school climate consists of three primary domains, each consisting of corresponding subdomains (Figure 1).


Questions in the WV School Climate Surveys have been mapped to this model. To assist schools in using their survey data, in this report results have been organized in a way that groups together all questions relating to each of the model domains and subdomains.

Results also are presented to facilitate easy comparison of school results to statewide results as they relate to desirable school climate conditions. In the example below (Figure 2) results are shown for two items related to the Engagement/Relationships part of the model. For these items the desirable condition is for a high percentage of students to agree with the statements.



In the example, on item 7b the school—having a greater percentage of students agreeing they are happy to be at their school—is doing well compared to students from around the rest of the state. A check is entered into the box under the "Better than State?" column to highlight this positive finding.

For item 7d, the percentage of students at the school agreeing that students are treated fairly by teachers is lower than the rest of the state as indicated by the negative value on the difference score. "No" is checked to indicate that the school is not doing as well. Because of this condition, this item also has been checked as a priority area that the school may work on to improve the learning environment.



To make the best use of this report to improve conditions for learning, school leadership, staff, and students should scan through the entire set of results and mark the school's status relative to the state as shown in the example. This should then be followed by a process by which priorities are selected and plans are made to implement interventions to address the priorities.
