Conditions within the State of West Virginia have changed and Putnam County Board of Education should be given another opportunity to review their local level data and resources. Local bond election results may yield additional resources for the county to bring on their final, remaining schools to the CEP. The bond means that the financial viability of the county is more reasonable to consider full CEP adoption than had it not passed. The State of West Virginia is requesting the opportunity to provide Putnam County Board of Education until January 1, 2025 to elect CEP for the 2024-2025 school year.
